Santa Mission's Literacy Improvement Project

The Santa Mission's Literacy Improvement Project is a great example of our one person, one project, and one club can help to be the inspiration working together together and help others make a difference!

The Federal Way Rotary Club has been supporting the Santa Mission's Literacy Improvement Project this year. Kirsten McLeod, a Peace Corps volunteer serving as an environmental educator in Guyana, South America had reached out to our club, earlier this year. Communication



is not easy, as the location is in the Amerindian village of Santa Mission, is remote and only 20 miles from the capital city, Georgetown, but only accessible by traveling two rivers. However, Kirsten's father shared the video in person with our club that she made showing the conditions and the effort and our club decided to help as a club project. The club and members decided to take this on and help raise funds (thank you to all our members!).

The update from late September was that they had painted two coats of paint on the interior walls (with the exception of the proposed ICT hub room, which will be painted purple) and have applied three coats of paint to the tables. We have placed new locks on the front and side door. They were then going to sand down the large bookshelves and plan to paint them. Also, they will be replacing rusted out nails in the roofing, cut the new window panes to their correct size, trim the new window frames to the correct size, paint the interior doors and paint the proposed ICT hub room.

It is easy to view your personal contributions report. All you need to do is:



- Go to the RI site <https://www.rotary.org> and click on MY ROTARY at the top of the page
- Sign in (or create your sign on if you have not previously set it up)
- At the bottom of the My Rotary page you should see Rotary Foundation – click there
- On the right of the next screen you will see “I want to” in a drop down menu – take “View my Giving History”, then click on Donor History Report
- At the bottom of the page you should have the option of two tabs – overview and transaction detail
 - Overview will show you your total giving
 - Transaction detail will show you detail of every donation you have made
