The LO Interact, otherwise known as the Teen Tech Tutors, spent Saturday afternoon, December 3rd at the Lake Oswego Adult Community Center (LOACC) with Director Ann Adrian and three adult center patrons...accessing the Internet with their digital devices.

Last year, the LO Interact Club, aka Teen Tech Tutors, came to the LOACC and offered to answer any questions that the LO adults had about their smart phones, digital tablets, or PC/Macs. This was such a successful community service project with happy adults mastering their new cell phones and tables that the LO Interact tutors offered to return this year.

Hunched over their digital devices, both LO Interact members and Rotarian, Jeremy Davis with his wife, Lacy, troubleshot issues and answered functional questions on the operations of their devices. Questions ranged from controlling

favorites in the photo app to merging a favorite profile photo with a phone number to understanding how to log on with passwords (this required the patron to take his tablet home and have Jeremy schedule a "house call" to solve).

The LOACC offered cookies, lemonade, water, and tea and then produced two large Bellagio pizzas for the LO volunteers. The pizzas were a big favorite.

The LOACC patrons left happy to have solved their digital device issues and the LO Interact members were happy to help.
