At the age 35 Mr.Read's father sold the business and moved the family to Spain then to Switzerland. Peter was 16 years old when the family was at Switzerland where he learned French. He then went to USF for college, married Carolyn. In 1966 his father gave him the business to run on trail basis and if he liked it, he would buy it from his father. Peter's Dad passed away at age 60 when Peter was age 40. This as you might imagine had a profound effect. Peter grew the business to 150 stores and over a billion dollars in sales. His brother joined him as well. Here are some of the rules/thoughts he used to grow the business. 1. Don't ask anyone to do things you wouldn't do. 2.
