Speaker Program: Larry Myers, Polio Plus Update

Larry Myers told us about his affliction with polio as a boy of 6 years old in southern California. Over 350,000 American youngsters were sickened in the 1940 to 1950s. The treatments (the Sister Elizabeth Kenny polio treatment) sounded more like medieval torture than healing. He survived, uncrippled but is was a searing, scary and long experience. At the beginning he was separated from his mom for 6 weeks. Larry told us about the efforts Rotary is making to eradicate polio and that to date the only countries reporting new cases are Pakistan and Afghanistan. Last year over 45 million youngsters were inoculated with the newest oral polio vaccine in Nigeria and 35 million in Pakistan and Afghanistan. The Gates foundation has pledged millions of dollars toward the battle to eliminate this scourge.

Concluding Breakfast: President Hugh thanked Larry for his presentation, gave him a Rotary Mug and sent everyone out for a successful week.
