Donna Davis from Expect More Arizona

Expect More Arizona is growing a movement of Arizonans who believe that every student in Arizona deserves a world-class education that will prepare them for college, careers and life. The players in building that system are not only the students, teachers and parents but also the voters.

To that end, this presentation will educate participants about education – where our vote counts and what it means for education in our state.

Donna Davis is the Senior Community Mobilizer of Expect More Arizona, a statewide public-private partnership dedicated to creating a movement of Arizonans who value education as our state’s top priority. Donna has over 20 years of experience in the non-profit sector, devoting most of her time to organizations that focus on youth, education and workforce development. She coordinated the Jobs for Valley Youth program for Valley of the Sun United Way and Greater Phoenix Leadership for six years. After 4 years of program management at Communities in Schools, Donna became a contractor. She did fund development for the FFA (Future Farmers of America) Foundation and coordinated a teacher training program called PASS (Partners Advancing Student Success) for the Arizona K-12 Center in which teachers visited workplaces for a week in the summer. Those experiences required statewide outreach and helped to develop Donna’s extensive professional network.
