Happy Hands is a school for children who are deaf, with hearing loss or with communication disorders, age 0-6 years.

The window to learn language is birth to age three. If the early window is missed, it is rarely recouped. Without specialized early language education, the average reading level of a deaf adult has been only third grade. Happy Hands opens the world of communication to the deaf child and his family.
