RYLA CODE OF CONDUCT

Rotary International District 6170 wishes to provide all of the participants of the RYLA Camp program with a safe secure setting. In order to do this, your cooperation with the **RULES is REQUIRED**. The following are the rules for all Rotary International District 6170 Camp RYLA Campers, Counselors, Volunteers, and Visitors.

- CAMP RYLA PARTICIPANTS ARE TO ARRIVE AT THE SCHEDULED TIME, AND TO ATTEND THE ENTIRE CAMP
- Campers are not to drive themselves to the 4-H Center or to have an automobile available to them during camp. In most cases ,the student will be transported to and from the camp by a Rotarian from their sponsor club.
- Campers are expected to attend all the scheduled activities and meals, unless excused by Camp RYLA Director
- You will be assigned to a cabin and group to make new friends. You may not change cabin or group without permission of the Camp RYLA Director
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs or medicine other than that is prescribed to the camper by their physician, tobacco products, firearms, knives, or any other weapons are prohibited and will result in the campers immediate expulsion from Camp RYLA. The campers parents will be responsible for transporting camper from the camp
- Televisions, Laptops, Video Games and any other solitary entertainment devices should not be brought to camp to allow for maximum interaction among camp RYLA participants.
- All Camp RYLA campers are required to wear appropriate clothing and nametags must be worn during waking hours
- Camp RYLA participants should not bring valuables, such as expensive jewelry or excessive amounts of money. Campers will be sleeping in cabins with no place to secure such items.
- Campers may bring their cell phones to Camp RYLA. However, mobile phones must be left in cabin with the exception of FREE TIME. Mobile phone should be TRUNED OFF at LIGHTS OUT each evening. Campers are responsible for safeguarding their own phones.
- Camp RYLA participants must respect the personal property of the individual participants and the property of the 4-H Center. Any participant who is responsible for damage, destruction or theft will be personally responsible for cost of replacement or repair of said property.
- Camp RYLA campers are NOT permitted in cabins of opposite gender

I have read and agree to abide by the rules and expectations set out above. Should the Camp RYLA participants conduct violate any of these rules or expectations, I understand that I can be dismissed from Camp RYLA and my parents/guardian will be notified to pick me up immediately
