2. An applicant cannot be an immediate family member (child or grandchild) of an active member of a Rotary club.
3. A copy of your high school transcript must accompany application.
4. Submit two letters of reference with application: One from your high school counselor, principal or teacher. The second letter from a responsible adult other than an educator or relative who knows your character, maturity, and financial need (example: employer, minister, friend of the family).
5. Applicants will be judged by the Rotary Scholarship Committee. A personal interview with the committee may be requested. The recipients will be announced and awards presented at the regular Hot Springs National Park Rotary Club meeting at noon on *Wednesday, April 25, 2018*.
