The Nation's Oldest and Most Versatile Law Enforcement Agency

July 25th, 2012

Although U.S. Marshall Jim Clark says most days are not nearly as exciting as Tommy Lee Jones' in the film, "U.S. Marshall," tracking down fugitives is a big part of the agency's mission. Marshall Clark oversees Kentucky's Western District encompassing all the counties from Louisville to the far west. Nationally, U.S. Marshalls arrested 36,000 fugitives and Clark was pleased to highlight a couple of out of state sex offenders who were apprehended here in our district.

When not tracking down fugitives, the three members of the Paducah office are focused on serving and protecting Federal Judges, the Federal Courthouse and transporting defendants for court appearances. The office also works with the state and local law enforcement on various task forces and is occasionally called on to perform extraditions and deportations.

The U.S. Marshall's Office was created in 1789 and is the nation's oldest law enforcement agency. There are 2,900 employees nationwide. Clark and his fellow U.S. Marshalls are appointed by the President of the United States to four year terms.
