"Call early and often"

Paducah Fire Chief Steve Kyle urges any one planning a remodel or new construction to contact the Department's Inspectors "early and often" throughout the process. The Paducah Fire Department is responsible for all code enforcement in the City, excluding plumbing, which is remains a responsibility of the state. Kyle said calling for consultation early in the process could save both time and money when dealing with electrical, building or mechanical codes.

Kyle is focused on "enhanced customer service," which includes advancements in technology and an Annual Code Class for contractors. "We are making strides toward providing an alternative to 'no,'" he said. Calling his office early gives the public a better idea of what

permits are required, as well as associated fees and what kind of inspections are required through construction.

Type of Occupancy and the amount of square footage in a project trigger different requirements under the code, especially as it relates of handicap accessibility. For example, a restaurant has stricter codes than a standard retail space. "It is important for the contractor and the owner to be knowledgeable early in the design process. We are here to help," he said.
