Can You Run Like a Mother?

February 11th, 2015



Pam Truitt, the Executive Director of the Paducah Family Services Society invites you to "Run Like a Mother" on Saturday, May 9th in the Iron Mom Half Marathon even if you aren't a mother. The 13.1 mile race begins at the Quilt Museum and winds around the West End, Noble Park, and Lowertown before ending at the Floodwall murals. The event is the signature fundraiser for the non-profit, which brought in \$40,000 last year.

Truitt says one doesn't have to be a seasoned marathon runner to participate either. There are two and four person relay teams who run 6 to 3 miles respectively to lighten the load. A couple hundred volunteers are also needed the day of the race, in addition to spectators along the route to encourage the runners. "You can even have block parties along the route," she said.

Vendors are invited to participate in the pre-race event held at the Sports Plex, as well as corporate sponsors for the event itself, which saw netted more than 1,000 registrations and nearly 900 finishers, of which 68% are women representing 23 states. Truitt says this year ten training scholarships will be awarded to runners in need, which includes a 12 week training plan.

The Family Service Society, founded in 1927, provides assistance with food, clothing, utilities, prescription medicines and dental care for those in need.
