Health to All

KentuckyCare, an Arkansas based non-profit health sources entity operates four clinics in western Kentucky with an eye on expanding throughout the Purchase Region. Emerson Goodwin, Regional Director for the Purchase KentuckyCare, said his agency's mission is "Health for all," which encompasses services from physicians to pharmacists on site. Since opening the first clinic in Bardwell in 2012, followed by another in Barlow and two more in Paducah, Goodwin said they are averaging 360 new patients each month.

KentuckyCare, which is a branch of the 30 year old ARcare, is a federally qualified health care organization.

This means, "we see everyone," said Goodwin. All patients with little or no insurance, or who now have Medicaid can get ongoing treatment. The organization is also active in the community through a KentuckyCare Shoe N 4Kids, which encourages kids to be more active and the Kentucky Family Health Foundation focusing on kids pre-school through 1st grade.
