Commissioner for the Kentucky Department for Public Health



Today the club welcomed **Dr. Stephanie Mayfield**, Commissioner for the Kentucky Department for Public Health. Dr. Mayfield is the first female and first African American to hold this position. She accepted this leadership position in September of 2012.

Dr. Mayfield shared the Cabinet for Health and Family Services official message on smoking. She shared that Kentucky ranks #1 in the nation in the number of citizens who smoke. Smoking is the number one cause of lung cancer and associated illness in the United State. In any seven day period, 50,000 non-smokers die from second hand smoke. It is the #1 cause

of preventable death.

In 2006 the General Surgeon's report stated that non-smoking policies reduces the number of smokers within communities and has a direct relationship to improved health for individuals living in those communities. The report showed a 22% decline in emergency room visits for asthma related conditions and a 15% decline in heart attack during the first year smoke free laws are enacted. Fayette County, Kentucky is a smoke free community. In that region the number of smokers living in the county declined by 16,500 saving the community an estimated \$21 million in healthcare related costs.

Dr. Mayfield refers to smoking as a public health issue. Rotarians wishing to become involved on the path to a smoke-free Kentucky are encouraged to contact their legislators to let them know of the local support for clean air in Kentucky.
