Paducah: "Distinctively Creative"



Rotarian Mary Hammond and her staff at the Paducah Convention and Visitors Bureau are basking in the success of having Paducah named a City of Crafts and Folk Art by UNESCO, the United Nations Educational, and Scientific Cultural Organization. This is a high honor of international importance, which has already led to a number of creative partnerships here and abroad.

Hammond, Executive Director of the CVB, said it has taken years of preparation of gain the designation in the elite group focused on promoting local creative industries and development plans. Paducah's already

successful projects were highlighted, such as Museum of the Quilters Society, Quilt Show, Lowertown and other arts focused programs were a distinct fit with the UNESCO program. Paducah is only the 7th city to earn the honor worldwide.

There are 41 members in 7 different cultural industry fields, including Literature, Architecture, Music and more, mostly European or Asian cities. Sante Fe is the only other U.S. city designated in the Crafts and Folk Art category along with Paducah. The designation has gained Paducah international media and led to a trip abroad for Hammond and Paducah Mayor Gayle Kaler to visit a Chinese city applying the designation. It has brought visitors from abroad to Paducah as artists and tourists. Culture is the oxygen of cities, said Hammond, who believes it will open a world of opportunities for Paducah as a tourist destination.
