2. RYLA helps students to:

- Build communication and problem-solving skills.
- Discover strategies for becoming a dynamic leader in their school or community.
- Learn from community leaders, inspirational speakers,

and peer mentors.

- Unlock your potential to turn motivation into action.

- Have fun and form lasting friendships.

3. The program is designed to find leadership potential in students that aren't yet aware that they have it within them, and draw it out.

4. It is often a life changing experience for participants, many of whom credit the experience for helping them to reach both personal and professional heights greater than they would have ever thought possible.

5. RYLA is a 3-day experience held annually at the Wendell Ford National Guard Training Center in Greenville, KY.

6. Last year's RYLA served 65 students from throughout our district.
