The Paducah Rotary Club had a delightful visit the **Group Study Exchange** team from New Zealand this week, which gave a slideshow tour of the native country, along with sharing information about their personal and professional lives.

The District 9920 Team represented the different regions of the nation, which is composed of 180 nationalities with a population of 4.3 million people.

Team leader, David Wong was born in Wellington, the capital of New Zealand. He is in

charge of capital risk management for the Bank of New Zealand.

Other team members include Keri Kimpton, a detective with the New Zealand Police; Terina Davis, and operations manager with the public health sector; Nellie Stallworthy, a Senior Probation Officer and Tim Rankin, a security investigator for the New Zealand military.

The group has visited Bardstown, Frankfort, Louisville and Murray, which served as the host club, and were scheduled to tour Paducah winding up with dinner at Whaler's Catch.
