-By participation in 4-H, youth learn leadership skills, teamwork, and public speaking. They also learn skills through participating in activities such as robotics, animal care, and shooting sports.

-At the luncheon McCracken County 4-Hers were recognized for excellence in several areas, including serving as camp counselors, participating in state horse and dog shows, and competing on a culinary team.
