Light Up Rotary!

October 22nd, 2014



Rotary District 6710 Governor Jayne Crisp is tasked with motivating all 58 clubs in our district to "Light Up Rotary" through numerous projects that fit into 6 areas of focus. Crisp had praise for the Paducah Club saying per capita giving was \$217 per member, which is the second highest rate in the district.

The Six Areas of Focus are

Peace and Conflict Prevention and Resolution, represented by the Peace Fellowship for students to attend one of five Peace Centers;

Disease Prevention and Treatment, including

Remote Area Medical Weekends in locations, such as Morehead this year and Greenville next year.

Water and Sanitation, represented by projects such as our own Club's Mexican water treatment plant and the Murray club's efforts to bring potable water to Ghana.

Maternal and Child Health, detecting and treating cervical cancer in Haitian women.

Basic Education and Literacy, an area of focus where the Paducah Club excels due to its unique Community Scholarship Program and the Summer Backpack Reading program.

Economic and Community Development, which is highlighted by the Louisville club's efforts to assist refugees and immigrants with micro funding and home repairs.

Crisp encouraged Rotarians to enroll in the Rotary Institute at Murray State University on Saturday, Nov. 1st. The leadership course costs \$70, but attendees receive a \$35 rebate upon completing the requirements. In addition, Rotarians should mark their calendars for the 2015 Rotary District Conference, which will be held in Paducah for the first time in 20 years next May 15-17. Festivities include fireworks, food, music and a parade.
