UK Expanding Business School

September 11th, 2013



The Gatton College of Business and Economics is expanding its physical presence on campus and its reach around the Commonwealth. Dr. David Blackwell, Dean of the business school, said the existing building on South Limestone would soon be gutted, rebuilt and expanded to offer new services to students. In addition, a new Angel Investor network will build out across Kentucky via the internet and conference calls making it easier for entrepreneurs and potential investors to connect.

The new facility, which will be built entirely with donated funds, follows with UK's priority to create Living Learning communities with spaces for students to interact outside the classroom. The new building will even feature an interactive Trading Room where students can learn how to trade the stock market. A joint Executive MBA program with U of L will allow some Gatton students to actively manage an investment fund and a portion of the UK's Endowment Fund.

The quality of UK applicants continues to break records with high ACT and SAT scores and a high number of National Merit Scholars. UK boasts a high retention rate for 1st, 2nd and 3rd year retention.
