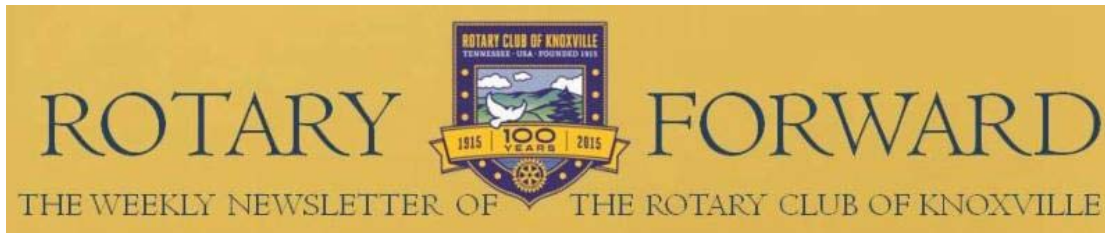

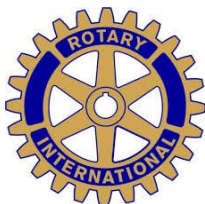

Mr. Goodwin has been the President and Chief Executive Officer of East Tennessee Children's Hospital since June of 2007. Prior to this experience he spent over 29 years at the Nationwide Children's Hospital in Columbus Ohio serving in positions ranging from housekeeper to interim CEO. In addition Mr. Goodwin served as the CEO of the Children's Hospital of Austin in Austin Texas from 1996 thru 1999 and from the year prior to joining

East Tennessee Children's Hospital served as the President of the Doctors Hospital in Columbus Ohio.

Mr. Goodwin holds an undergraduate degree from The Ohio State University in Health Education as well as a Certificate from School of Public Health's Executive Program in Health Care Financial Management. Mr. Goodwin completed his Masters degree in Business Administration from Capital University in Columbus Ohio and has held adjunct faculty positions in hospital administration from both The Ohio State University and the University of Minnesota.

Mr. Goodwin has always been committed to the community in which he lives and currently serves on the Boards of the Ronald McDonald House, the East Tennessee Foundation, the Metropolitan Drug Commission, the Knox County Imagination Library and the Knoxville Chamber of Commerce. In addition to these activities he has completed both the "Introduction Knoxville" and Leadership Knoxville courses. Program Recap - April 12, 2016



Rear Admiral Terry J. Moulton
Deputy Surgeon General and Deputy Chief,
Bureau of Medicine and Surgery of the
United States Navy

Rotarian **Joe Sutter** introduced **Rear Admiral Terry J. Moulton**, Deputy Surgeon General and Deputy Chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery of the United States Navy. Admiral Moulton is a Nashville native and Western Kentucky graduate, and is married to a Knoxville native. Admiral

Moulton was in Knoxville for Navy Week festivities.

Admiral Moulton began his presentation with a video of Naval health care that focused on battlefield, patient care, research and development, wounded warriors, at-sea medicine and humanitarian aid. The video concluded with the goal of military health care - World-class Care, Anytime, Anywhere.

Admiral Moulton is participating as a representative of Navy health care in a naval outreach program. The goal of the program is to share with citizens the value of the Navy. Protecting maritime shipping, global trade and undersea cables are all important activities of the Navy. The Navy operates a huge health care network, with some 9.6 million beneficiaries. The Naval Medical Service supports the United States Marines, as well.

The Navy Medical Service strategic priorities include readiness, jointness (functioning with other services and allies), and providing value at home. In the recent Gulf Storm campaign, 98% of injured veterans survived.

Weekly Polio Update

Polio Headlines:

The third Outbreak Response Assessment in Madagascar found that the surveillance system is not yet strong enough to conclude that polio transmission has been interrupted. Thirty-nine high-risk districts have been identified to receive focused attention.



There is one week to go until the [globally synchronized switch](#) from the trivalent to bivalent oral polio vaccine. Learn more about the switch through this [series of videos](#).

Afghanistan: No new cases of wild poliovirus 1 (WPV1) were reported in the past week. The more recent occurred in Nawzad district of Hilmand province, with onset of paralysis on 23 January. The total number of WPV1 cases for 2016 remains 2, compared to 1 reported for 2015 at this point last year.

Pakistan: No new cases of wild poliovirus 1 (WPV1) were reported in the past week. The last was recorded in Skirkarpur district of Sindh province, with onset of paralysis on 5 March. The total number of WPV1 cases for 2016 remains 6, compared to 20 reported for 2015 at this point last year.

Free parking is available at First Presbyterian Church Knoxville, TN. (Thank you, William Pender!)

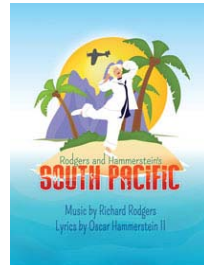
