Rotary Information

The Rotary Foundation Recognition

The Rotary Foundation shows its appreciation to individuals and clubs for personal outright contributions supporting its humanitarian and educational activities.

Individual Recognition Opportunities

- **Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member** is an individual who contributes \$100 or more each year to the Annual Fund. These contributions count toward Paul Harris Fellow and other recognitions.
- **Paul Harris Fellow** recognition is given to an individual who contributes (or in whose name is contributed) \$1,000 or more cumulatively to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or an approved Foundation grant. Multiple Paul Harris Fellows recognition is given as subsequent \$1,000 levels.
- **The Paul Harris Society** recognizes Rotarians and friends who personally contribute \$1,000 or more to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or an approved Foundation grant every year.
- **Major Donors** are individuals or couples whose combined giving has reached \$10,000.
- **The Arch C. Klumph Society** includes donors who contribute \$250,000 or more.
- **A Benefactor** is an individual who informs The Rotary Foundation in writing that he or she has provided for the Foundation in his or her estate plan or makes an outright gift of \$1,000 or more to the Endowment Fund.
- **The Bequest Society** recognizes couples or individuals who have made commitments in their estate plans totaling \$10,000 or more.
