PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Using DaCdb and Rotary Internet Resources

Devrin Kuipers

Secretary Devrin Kuipers gave a brief tutorial on using DaCdb, the membership management tool adopted by District 6780. All members were emailed a login to use the tool, but may need to contact Devrin for their password.

DaCdb is an Internet resource accessible from any computer browser or device with Internet access. If properly used, DaCdb can be a very powerful tool for Club administration. The program includes member information, Club committees, a calendar feature, attendance module, treasurer module, website hosting, and a bulletin feature. Devrin showed some of the navigation of the application.

Devrin also discussed the District 6780 and Rotary International websites. The District 6780 website has useful information for project information and committees within the District. Devrin recommends using Rotary International's My Rotary portal for making direct contributions to The Rotary Foundation.

Kroger Community Rewards Program

To use the Kroger Community Rewards Program, you should register online at www.krogercommunityrewards.com.

- Be sure to have your Kroger Plus card handy and register your card with your organization (**Oak Ridge Rotary Sunset Community Fund**) after you sign up.
- If you do not have a Kroger Plus card, you can get one at the customer service desk in the store.
- Click on **Sign In/Register**.
- Most participants are new online customers, so they must click on **SIGN UP TODAY** in the **'New Customers'** box.
- Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account: enter your zip code, click on **Favorite Store** enter your email address and create a password, and agree to the terms and conditions.
- You will then get a message to check your email and click on the link within the body of the email.
- Click on **My Account** and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on **Edit Kroger Community Rewards** information and input your Kroger Plus card number.
- Update or confirm your information.
- Enter NPO number (**65746**) or name of the organization, select organization from list and click on **Confirm**.
- To verify that you are enrolled correctly, you will see your organization's name on the right side of your information page.
- REMEMBER, purchases will not count for our club until after you register your card.
- To use your phone number to register, call 800-576-4377 and select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number.
- You must swipe your registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to your registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for each purchase to count.
