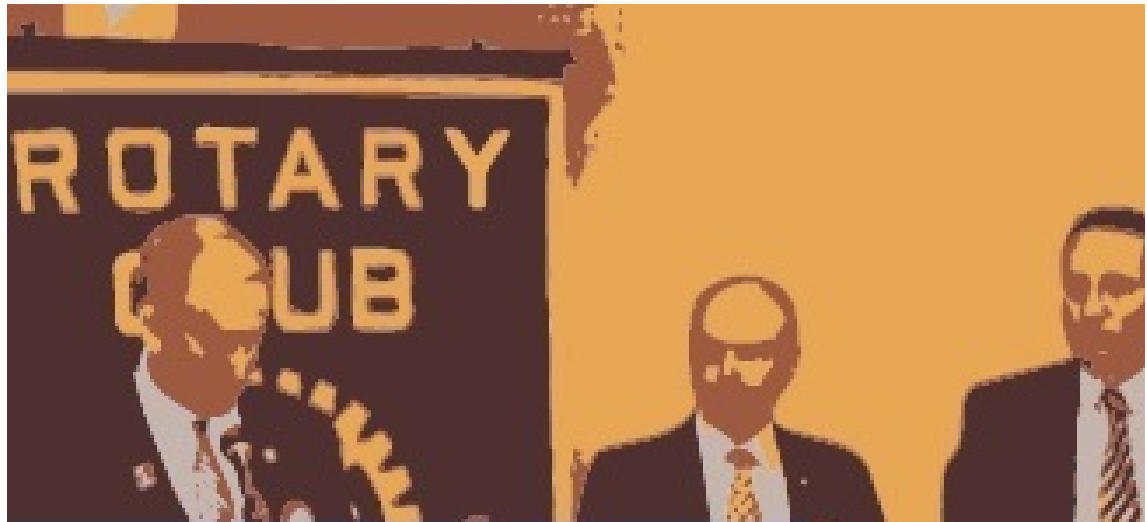
### MEMBERSHIP

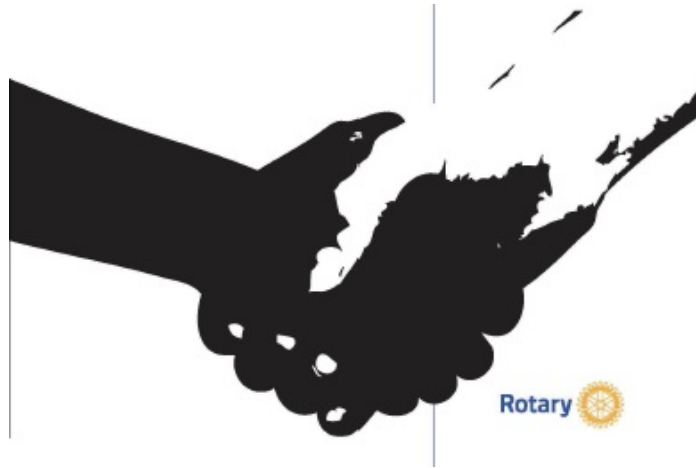
