Over 60 individuals went to Honduras on March 15, 2014 for a week of volunteer/mission work at Rancho el Paraiso, San Esteban, Olancho, Honduras. The ranch is located in the Agalta Valley located seven hours northeast of Tegucigalpa, the capital city of Honduras.



The trip was organized by Honduras Outreach, Inc. whose office is in Tucker. The leader of our group was Bob Hope, a public relations executive, who has been leading these groups every year for 18 years.

athletic director at the University of Georgia and our leader, Bob Hope. The majority of our group did physical work in leveling ground in front of an elementary school in

preparation for future construction. We also moved crushed gravel and placed it around the perimeter of a soccer field being built at another school. We then planted hedges around two sides. The field was dedicated "Dooley Field" in honor of coach Dooley.

All of our meals were prepared by the ranch staff. We stayed in men and women's dorms. In addition to those of us doing the grunt work, there was a team of veterinarians with us who went to several small cities and voluntarily treated animals. There was also a team of engineers who were



there to draft plans for a bridge to be built over a river at a future date. Joe and Barbara Stock and another couple provided audiology services for school children and others needing hearing help. We also had a doctor with our group who worked in the medical clinic to assist locals with their medical problems.

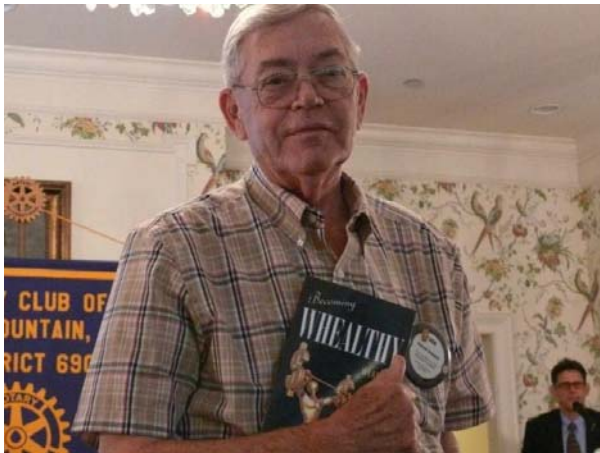

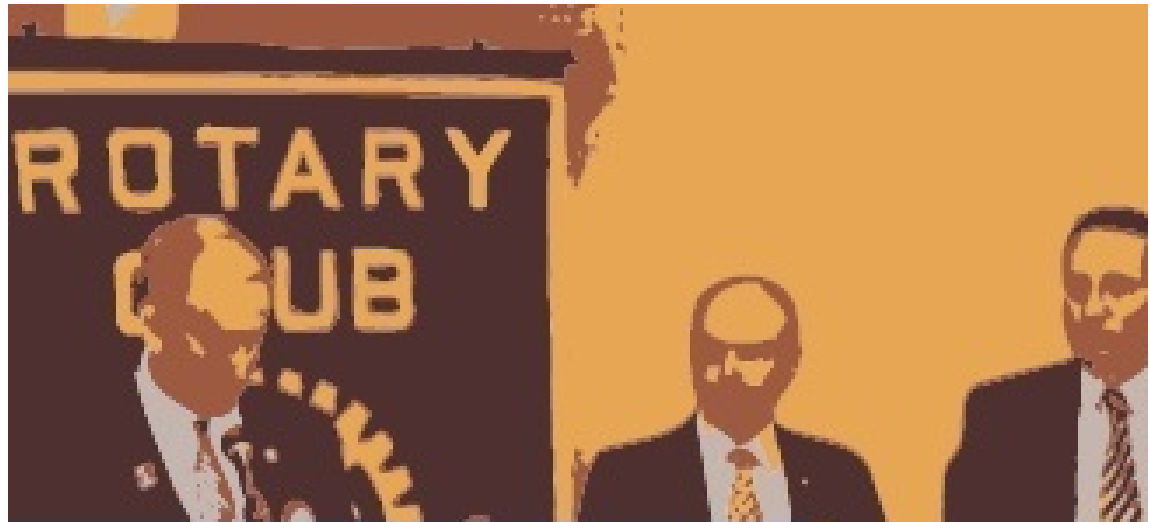
### MEMBERSHIP

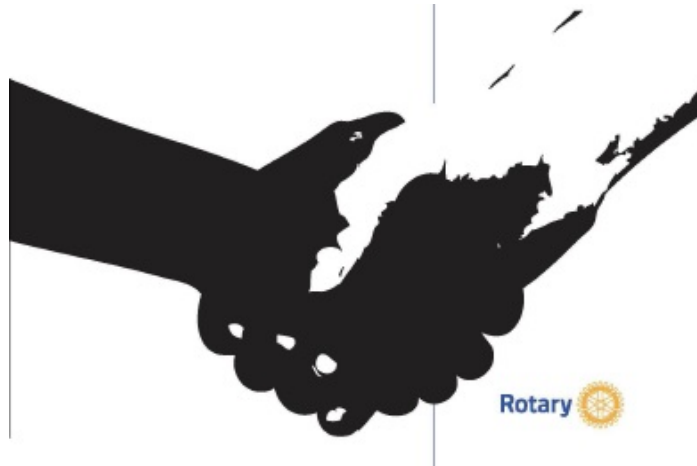
