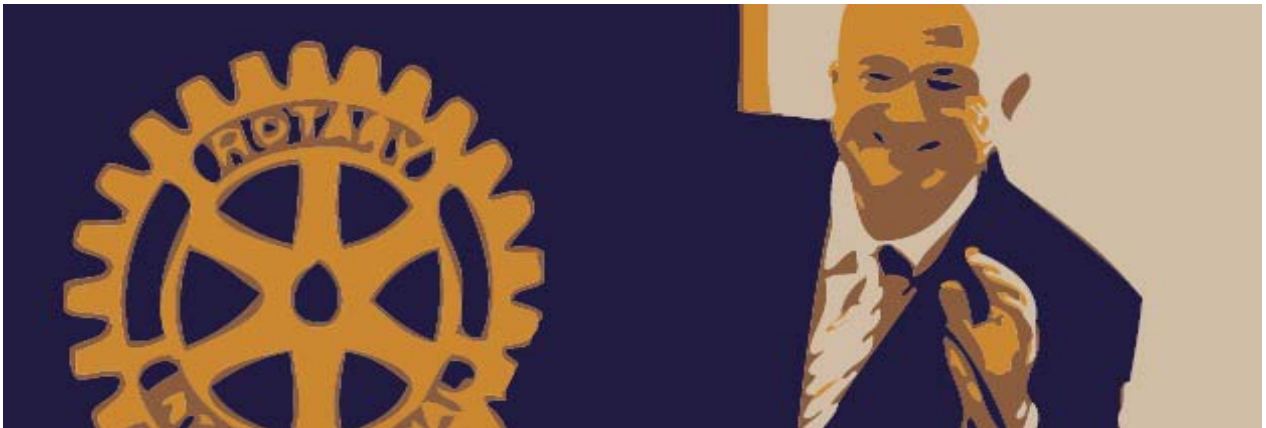

ATTENDANCE

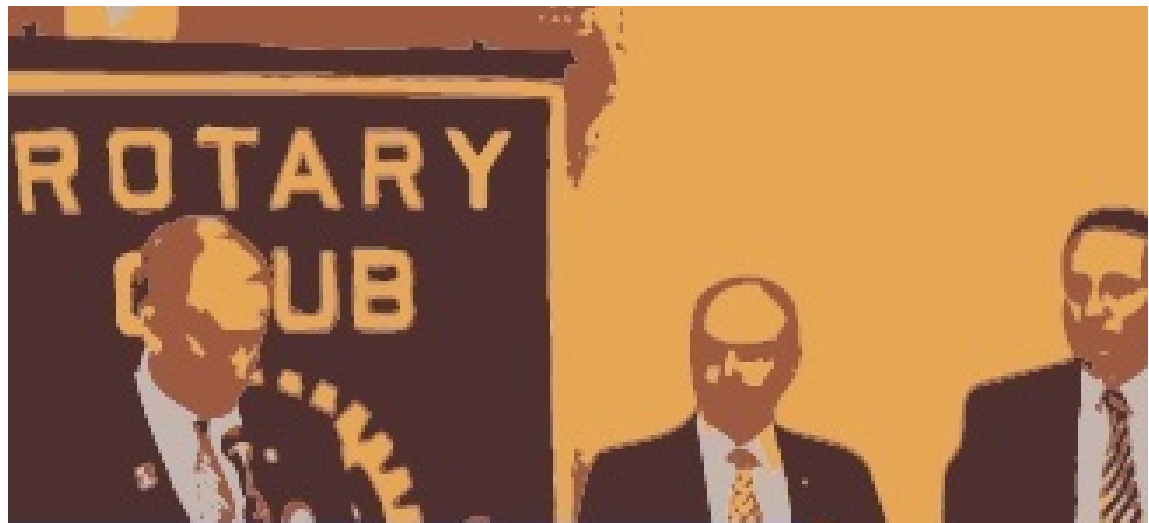

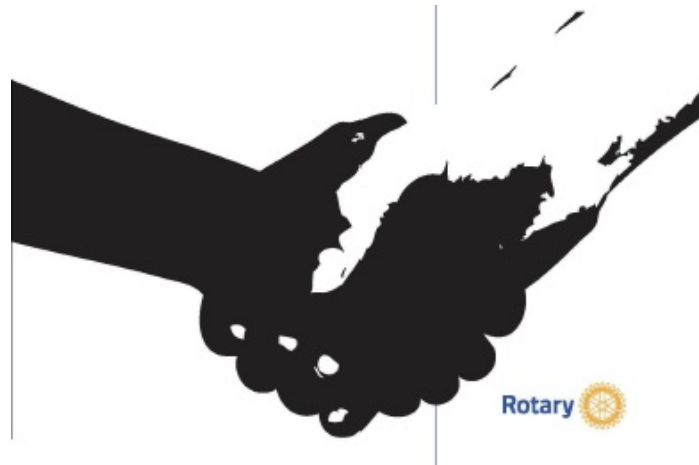
