Healthy Nation's mission is to promote a healthy population through health education and disease prevention one person, one family, and one community at a time.

How the Program Works

Health Nation employs a community health model. They deploy nurses and other health workers to meet with their members for a once-a-monthly wellness check-up. They come to you and meet you right where you are!

Their on-call medical director provides Mobile support to all nurses in the field. They keep your health records in electronic format. Patient information is safely stored using health management software (HMS). This reduces errors and misplacements of data.

Three of the refugee families with whom 50 Cents. Period. works lost their homes in an apartment fire on Tuesday night. We are helping to coordinate relief efforts, along with their resettlement agencies and the Atlanta Red Cross. Furniture and clothing are pouring in, but we need some assistance with gathering personal toiletry items, cleaning supplies, kitchen and bath towels, underwear, socks, laundry detergent, and dictionaries/notebooks for their English classes. The families are newly arrived from Burma, totaling 19 persons in all. Any assistance our club can provide is much welcomed and appreciated. If you can help, please bring any of these items to our meeting next Tuesday, and I will collect and transport the items to the families.

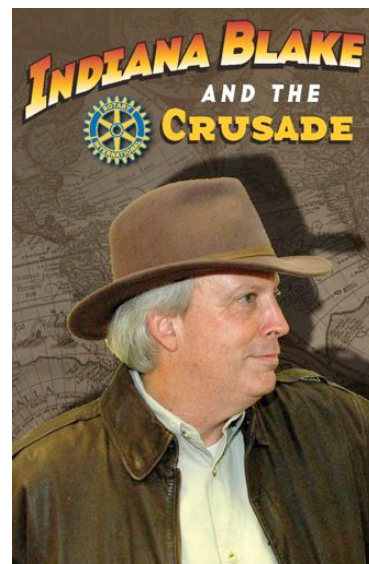
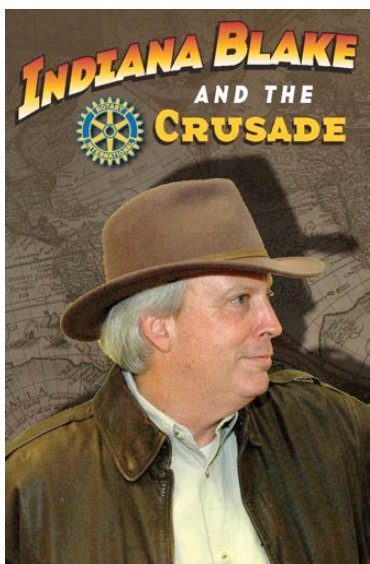
