The South Forsyth Community Improvement District (CID) is an initiative of business leaders committed to maintaining and enhancing the South Forsyth community. With the goal of investing in an even more vibrant and sustainable South Forsyth, the CID will serve as a catalyst for transportation planning, investment and improvement.

HB 892, authored by Rep. Mike Dudgeon, allows commercial property owners in South Forsyth to vote on the creation of a CID for the purposes of constructing a new interchange at McGinnis Ferry Road and GA 400 and funding other infrastructure improvements in the area.

As a self-taxing district, the prospective CID will be funded by a voluntary tax, paid by commercial property owners within the District's boundaries. These funds will support efforts to improve the area.
