Individual civic, charitable, professional, and business service performed as a volunteer is preferred to similar service of an individual performed as an extension as an employee of a substantial business enterprise. Service rendered by the individual for which he or she received salary or fees, or by which the nominee makes his living will receive minimum consideration. The heaviest weight will be given to those activities performed at some personal or professional sacrifice and for which the individual receive no general compensation. Simply doing a superlative job in one's own vocation would not be sufficient qualification for the award, although unusual professional or business achievement to the benefit of the community is part of the total picture. Non-paid community service, which might include church or civic work, is the important criterion.

In selecting the Man/Woman of the Year, the nominee’s entire past career of volunteer civic service will be considered with possible emphasis on the current year. However, the nominees’ activities in the current year are not necessarily decisive.

Individual civic, charitable, professional, and business service performed as a volunteer is preferred to similar service of an individual performed as an extension as an employee of a substantial business enterprise. Services rendered by the individual for which he or she received salary or fees, or by which the nominee makes his living will receive minimum consideration. The heaviest weight will be given to those activities performed at some personal or professional sacrifice and for which the individual received no general compensation. Simply doing a superlative job in one’s own vocation would not be sufficient qualification for the award, although unusual professional or business achievement to the benefit of the community is part of the total picture. Non-paid community service, which might include church or civic work, is the important criterion.
