New Billing Procedure Effective July 1, 2013

One of the requests from Rotary International (RI) is that all individual clubs qualify for "Every Rotarian, Every Year" (EREY). What this means is that each club donates \$100.00 per member to RI's Annual Fund. The Annual Fund is the lifeblood of Rotary. This money is used for international, major projects. In addition, a portion of it returns to our District and can be used for such things as a group study exchange and/or a local grant.

We currently bill each member \$25.00 per quarter (\$100.00 annually) which is sent to RI and applied to the Annual Fund. Because of the way RI accounts for this money, however, beginning July 1, 2013 (the start of our new fiscal year), all active members will be billed the full \$100.00 each July. We apologize for any inconvenience and, of course, you will be billed \$25.00 less for each of the remaining three quarters.

Reminder About Paying Your Dues

It is important that all members pay their quarterly invoices upon receipt. In addition to paying for your weekly meals at The Chesterfield, invoices also cover any guests you may have brought. Additionally, a portion goes to our local foundation, a portion goes to RI, and a portion goes to club operations.

Currently, your Bylaws provide that any member who is over 60 days past due is "automatically suspended". A sub-committee of your Board has decided to review this provision and recommend an amendment in order to clarify the issue of delinquency.

In the meantime, we ask any currently delinquent members to please bring your financial obligations current as soon as possible. The next quarterly billing statement (4/1/13-6/30/13) has just been e-mailed out.

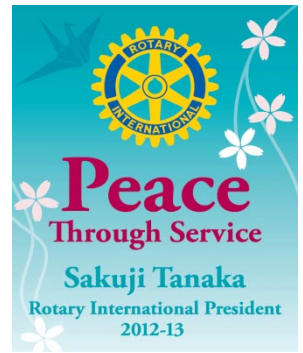
