10th – Family Night at Pat Reeves Village*. Pat Reeves is the only emergency shelter in Palm Beach County for homeless families with dependent children. Pat Reeves is one of the programs offered by the Center For Family Services. Join us from 5:30 - 7:00 p.m., as we host dinner for the families in residence. Pat Reeves is located at 1320 Henrietta Avenue, West Palm Beach. *Directions (from Palm Beach): Flagler Drive north to Palm Beach Lakes. Turn left and cross Dixie. Go up and over a bridge. At the bottom of the bridge, you reach Sapodilla. Turn left and **IMMEDIATELY** turn left again so that so are going down a small road that goes under the bridge. Go straight to Henrietta Avenue. Turn left on Henrietta and Pat Reeves is on the right.*

11th – Service Above Self Award for April at Palm Beach Day Academy. The program starts at 8:00 am and lasts approximately 45 minutes. PBDA is located at 241 Seaview Avenue.

12th – Great American Beach Clean-up. Clean-up is from 9:00 am – 12 Noon. The beach clean-up is being coordinated by Diane Buhler. She will supply gloves and bags and will issue temporary parking passes. For any students, community service hours are offered. She will have water but not plastic water bottles.
