On March 4<sup>th</sup>, the Service Above Self Award was presented to two students at Palm Beach Day Academy.

Sydney Kosoy, a seventh grade student, was recognized for her outstanding community service. Most recently, Sydney volunteered at the Feeding Children Everywhere event, where 137,000 nutritious meals were packaged at one location in one afternoon. Sydney said of the experience: "There are people just ten minutes away from where I live that need help. Spending a few hours packaging meals

opened my eyes to the world around me".

Ninth grade student Shane Knopp was the other recipient. He submitted an essay about the feeling he gets when he hands out sandwiches to the homeless: "It makes me feel humble to see how grateful these people are in accepting a bag of food. I see genuine 'thanks' in their eyes".

Our final Service Above Self presentation for the 2015-16 school year will be Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, followed by a special Rotary breakfast on Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, honoring all of our recipients this year with their families.
