Thanks to the efforts of several Club members, we now have our own official website! Robi Jurney has agreed to oversee its content. We will be further customizing it for our needs in the coming months.

We list our website at the top of our monthly newsletter. The "easiest" way to gain access is, as follows:

Type: www.palmbeachflagler.rotary-clubs.org in your browser window and hit "enter" or "go". Once our website opens up, save it as a "favorite". In this way, you can re-connect at any time by clicking one button, instead of having to re-type the long name each time.

Robi hopes to offer a computer lesson at one of our regular weekly meetings. She will have a computer and a projector available and will "walk us" through all of the things that our website has to offer. Some of these include: a link to our District's website; a link to Rotary International's website; a list of local area make-up locations and times; club member information; and general Rotary information.

Also on our website is a link to a Rotary E-Club. What is that??? Let's say you can't make a regular weekly meeting. Maybe you are going away on vacation for a few weeks or for the entire Summer. Ideally, you are supposed to "make up" at another club. This gives you the opportunity to meet new people and see how other clubs operate differently from ours. RI requires members to attend at least 50% of weekly meetings monthly. Some clubs are stricter than ours. If you do not meet your attendance requirement, you are dropped from Rotary. We are not as "hard and fast" but we do encourage meeting minimum attendance as an "aspirational" goal.

The first Rotary on-line eClub was chartered in January of 2001. Its mission is to connect, inform and inspire members who are traveling or have scheduling conflicts which prevent them from fulfilling traditional attendance requirements. In 2004, Rotary's Council on Legislation officially recognized the makeup feature of officially sanctioned eClubs to allow attendance ("make up") credit for a 30-minute interactive website activity. We will provide further information in next's month's newsletter.

Rotary International News: In 1911, the second convention of the National Association of Rotary Clubs of America was held in Portland, Oregon. It was there that the seeds of Rotary’s official mottos were sown: “Service, Not Self”, which was later modified to the current “Service Above Self”, became the “principal motto” of Rotary because it best conveys the philosophy of unselfish volunteer service. A secondary motto was also approved, which was also modified over the years to its current wording: “One Profits Most Who Serves Best”.
