Due to the sensitive nature of this visit, please note these strict rules and requirements:

1. You must advise Colleen if you plan to attend no later than Sunday, December 1st. If your name is not on the attendance list, you will not be admitted.
2. No weapons, including pocket knives.
3. No cell phones.
4. No name tags.
5. No purses or briefcases.
6. No "open toed" shoes or suggestive clothing.

We are to park across the street from the facility at Lake Lytal Park, which is 3645 Gun Club Road, West Palm Beach. Promptly at 7:30am, our group will be transported by bus to the Corrections Facility.

We will be served breakfast on the top floor of the jail and we will be given a guided jail tour directly after. At the completion of the tour, the bus will return us to the parking area.

Please remember to sign up immediately if you plan to attend!

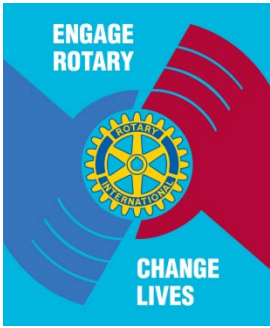
