The Palm Beach Flagler Rotary Foundation

Our Club has formed a separate 501(c)(3) charitable foundation for the purpose of soliciting funding in order to support the work of approved charitable organizations in Palm Beach County. Once each year, our Foundation (not to be confused with Rotary International's Foundation) advertises for local, qualified charitable organizations to submit proposals to our Grants Allocation Committee. In order to be eligible for grant approval, the need must be in the area of either Literacy; Health Care; or Homelessness & Hunger.

In late Fall of 2010, we received 11 grant proposals. Following a diligent review of each request, your Foundation approved the following grants for calendar year 2010:

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- (1) Adopt-a-Family - \$1000.00
 - (2) Boca Helping Hands - \$1500.00
 - (3) Palm Beach Gardens Elementary School - \$1000.00
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These monetary grants will allow the above organizations to purchase food vouchers for the homeless and needy individuals; purchase computer equipment and provide technical support to disadvantaged individuals in connection with a job placement and mentoring program; and allow elementary students to write original stories, publish their own books, and display same in their school library.

THE JESSE NEWMAN SPIRIT OF PALM BEACH FUND

Created through a challenge grant by Admiral Phil Whitacre, the Jesse Newman Spirit of Palm Beach Fund has been established as an annual gift in recognition of an individual living/working on the Island of Palm Beach who demonstrates “Service Above Self,” and who makes a difference in the lives of those he or she touches in some way. The recipient could be a fireman or policeman, a server at a restaurant, a community volunteer, a city employee, etc. – *anyone* who makes a difference in the lives they touch...no matter how that interaction happens.

The PBFRC Foundation will receive recommendations in November of each year from members of the Club and community for potential candidates for this recognition. At the Club’s meeting on the second Tuesday in December, the recipient will be recognized and presented with a “Christmas gift from Jesse” in the amount of \$500.00.

PBFRC News: On December 7th, our Club made its annual trip to Hope Rural School in Indiantown and distributed approximately 50 dictionaries to all of the 4th and 5th grade students. We had a few left over dictionaries, so those were donated to The Milagro Center, together with our toy donations.
