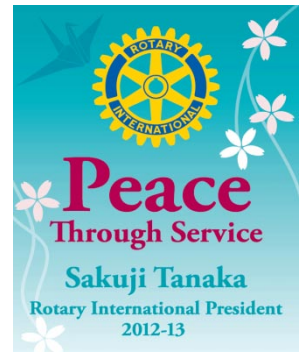

In order to qualify for the SASA, students must submit an essay to Outreach Coordinator and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher Cynthia Kanai summarizing what they have completed in the way of community service and/or what leadership actions they have taken that embody the ideals of Rotary's 4-Way Test. A panel of teachers then evaluates these essays and selects one recipient for the monthly award.

In addition to his many hours of local community service, Teddy was recognized for his years of dedication in the Boy Scouts and his near completion of his designation as an Eagle Scout.

An Eagle Scout is the highest rank attainable in the Boy Scouting program of the Boy Scouts of America. Requirements include earning at least 21 merit badges and demonstrating Scout Spirit through the Boy Scout Oath and Law, service, and leadership. This includes an extensive service project that the Scout plans, organizes, leads, and manages.
