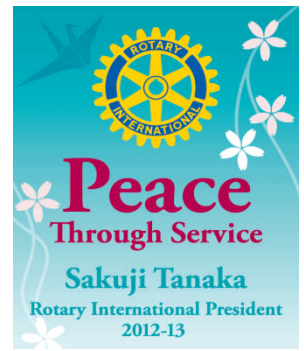

2 CHARITABLE FOUNDATIONS: CONFUSED?

As a member of the PBFRC, you periodically hear about two charitable foundations that our Club is involved with. Both are 501(c)(3) organizations.

The first is the Rotary Foundation. The Rotary Foundation (RF) is considered "the lifeblood of Rotary" and was started in 1917 by Arch Klumph, the 6th president of Rotary International. Its purpose was to create an endowment for "doing good in the world" through charitable, educational, and other avenues of service. Today, over \$70 million dollars is contributed annually to Rotary's Annual Fund and helps fund Rotary globally. It tackles major projects such as polio eradication, clean water, and disaster relief, as well as funds international scholarships, group study exchanges and peace initiatives. Every member of the PBFRC is a "Sustaining Member" which means that you have contributed at least \$100.00 to RF. We strongly encourage all members to become "Paul Harris Fellows" which you attain when you contribute a total of \$1000.00 to RF.

The second is the Palm Beach Flagler Rotary Foundation. This foundation is unique to our Club and allows us to make annual donations locally to organizations that our Foundation Committee deem worthy of support. This year, we were able to fund three grants of \$1500.00 each: one to Junior Achievement BizTown at Segull Academy; one to Center For Family Services new Teddy Bear Program; and one to "April is for Authors" literacy initiative, all in Palm Beach County.

In this way, we can help others both locally and internationally and fulfill Paul Harris' mission to "do good in the world".
