ROTARY INTERNATIONAL'S THEME FOR 2012-13: "PEACE THROUGH SERVICE"

Each year, the incoming RI President announces a new "theme" for all Rotary Clubs. The current theme is "Reach Within to Embrace Humanity" and the theme logo is printed on the front of this newsletter. RI President-elect Sakuji Tanaka (who takes office on July 1, 2012) has announced his theme as "Peace Through Service". Quoting PE Tanaka: "Peace, in all of the ways that we can understand it, is a real goal and a realistic goal for Rotary". By helping others (i.e. Service), we can help to build peace. "This is a lesson that I think the whole world can learn from, in a positive way. When we see the needs of others as more important than our own needs—when we focus our energies on a shared goal that is for the good of all—this changes everything", he said. "It changes our priorities in a completely fundamental way. And it changes how we understand the idea of peace".

The new Peace Through Service logo will be unveiled and published monthly on the front side of our newsletter, starting with the July issue.

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL (RI) NEWS:

Rotary International has designated certain days of the year as times for Rotary clubs to emphasize the involvement of all Rotarians in designated activities. **The week of March 13th is observed as World Rotaract Week.** Rotaract is a Rotary-sponsored service club for young men and women ages 18 to 30. There are over 7800 Rotaract clubs in 158 countries. They are usually community-based or university based and are sponsored by a local Rotary club, making them true "partners in service" and key members of the Rotary family.

Thursday, March 1 thru Saturday, March 3 is the annual President Elect Training Seminar (PETS) in Orlando, Florida. All incoming Presidents for 2012-13 are required to attend.
