Ambassadorial Scholarships, The Rotary Foundation's oldest and best-known program, was founded in 1947. Since then, more than 40,000 men and women from about 100 nations have studied abroad under its auspices. Today it is one of the world's largest privately funded international scholarships programs. Nearly 500 scholarships (from 50 countries) were awarded for study in 2010-11, with grants totaling approximately US\$12.5 million.

The Ambassadorial Scholarships program supports The Rotary Foundation's ultimate goal of world understanding and peace by:

- Increasing awareness of, and respect for, cultural differences by sending ambassadors of goodwill to study in another country;
- Instilling in scholars Rotary's ideal of 'Service Above Self' through active participation in Rotary service projects;
- Encouraging scholars to dedicate their personal and professional lives to improving the quality of life for the people of their home community and country;
- Developing leaders who can address the humanitarian needs of the world community;
- Impacting all areas of the world through a balanced geographical distribution of scholars;
- Encouraging Rotarians worldwide to increase the educational opportunities for scholars from low-income countries; and
- Fostering a lifelong association between Rotary and its scholars.

On April 12th, Club members were fortunate to hear a heartfelt speech from Natalie Castellanos, District 6930's ambassadorial scholar for 2009-10. Natalie spent one year in District 4890, Buenos Aires, Argentina, studying international law at the University of Buenos Aires. Natalie graduated from the University of Florida in 2007 and is now finishing up her law degree at Florida International University. She plans to take the Bar exam in June.

Natalie has developed a love for Rotary and sees Rotary, through programs like the Ambassadorial Scholarship Program, changing the world in a most positive way.
