NOW THAT YOU KNOW ABOUT RYLA DO YOU KNOW ABOUT RYE?

Last month, Severe Weather Expert Mike Lyons (a member of the Singer Island Rotary Club) spoke to us about RYLA. An article about RYLA was published in our October newsletter.

Rotary Youth Exchange (RYE) Florida is an opportunity for a local student, aged 15 – 18.5, to spend 10 months living with host families in other countries and attending school. There are over 30 countries that participate with Florida exchanges.

A Rotary Youth Exchange student acts as an ambassador of the United States. He or she is adopted by a Rotary club in a host country. That individual attends school and lives as an “active family member” (not a guest) with 2-4 different host families. The student becomes fluent in another language and learns responsibility and resourcefulness. In return, our RYE student teaches the people he/she meets about our country, our culture, and our ideals.
