First ‘Service Above Self’ Award Recipient is Selected

On October 31st, the Palm Beach Day Academy selected 8th grade student Lulu Fanjul as the first ‘Service Above Self’ Award Recipient for the 2013-14 school year.

Cynthia Kanai, Community Service Director for PBDA, recognized Lulu at the weekly school assembly. “Lulu has been involved in every Quantum House event, every Paley Kids event, and every snack making event (for less fortunate children) we have had for years!”

The ‘Service Above Self’ Award is presented to one student who has excelled in community service and leadership. In order to qualify for the SASA, students must submit an essay to Mrs. Kanai summarizing what they have completed in the way of community service and/or what leadership actions they have taken that embody the ideals of Rotary’s 4-Way Test. A panel of teachers then evaluates these essays and selects one recipient for the monthly award.

Rotary’s Four-Way Test
Followed by Rotarians worldwide in their business and professional lives, The Four-Way Test was created by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in 1932. It has since been translated into more than 100 languages.

3. Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
