First 'Service Above Self' Award Recipient is Selected

On October 16th, the Palm Beach Day Academy selected one student as recipient for the first 'Service Above Self' Award for the 2015-16 school year: 8th Grade Student Griffin Johnson.

Cynthia Kanai, Community Service Director for PBDA, recognized Griffin at the weekly school assembly. "Griffin is dedicated to all Service and has a heart for others. He has participated in the End Hunger Walk, he regularly volunteers at Quantum House, and he traveled with PBDA to the Dominican Republic to help introduce and set up a long standing athletic tradition of ours, 'Field Day', to a local school".

The 'Service Above Self' Award is presented monthly to 1-2 students who have excelled in community service and leadership. In order to qualify for the SASA, students must submit an essay to Mrs. Kanai summarizing what they have completed in the way of community service and/or what leadership actions they have taken that embody the ideals of Rotary's 4-Way Test. A panel of teachers then evaluates these essays and selects the recipient(s) for the monthly award.

Our next presentation will be on Friday, December 4th, and all Rotarians are invited (and encouraged) to attend. The work that we are doing jointly with PBDA, together with the many, many other community service projects spearheaded by Mrs. Kanai, are what will help develop our Rotarians of the future.
