ROTARY DISTRICT 6930 NEWS:

WHAT EXACTLY IS RYLA???

Our final speaker in October is Mike Lyons. Mike is well known as the Severe Weather Expert for local Channel 25 WPBF. What is less known is that, for many years now, Mike (a member of the Singer Island Rotary Club) has been the District 6930 Chair for RYLA.

RYLA stands for Rotary Youth Leadership Awards and is an official program of Rotary International. It is an intensive training program that brings together youth and young adults, ages 14-30, to further develop character and leadership skills and learn about Rotary. RYLAs often take the form of a seminar, camp or workshop, generally 3-10 days in length, organized by Rotarians at the club, district, or multidistrict level. Participants are nominated by local Rotary clubs which often cover all expenses. RYLA gives Rotarians the opportunity to mentor promising young leaders and, in turn, develop future Rotarians. Next year’s District 6930 Assembly will be held in late March or mid-April. This past RYLA was a 4-day event held in Port St. Lucie. All clubs in our District are being asked to help sponsor at least one delegate for 2012.

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL (RI) NEWS:

Rotary International has designated certain days and months of the year as times for Rotary clubs to emphasize the involvement of all Rotarians in designated activities. Clubs are encouraged to plan special programs on the appropriate topics during these months. **October is designated as Vocational Service Month**, a time to highlight Rotary’s contribution to the second Avenue of Service. In addition, **the week of October 28th is observed as World Interact Week**. Interact is Rotary International’s service club for young people ages 12-18. There are over 10,000 Interact clubs in 118 countries. Interact clubs are sponsored by individual Rotary clubs, which provide support and guidance, but Interact clubs are self-governing and self-supporting.
