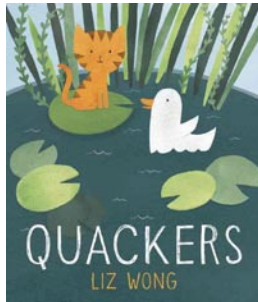

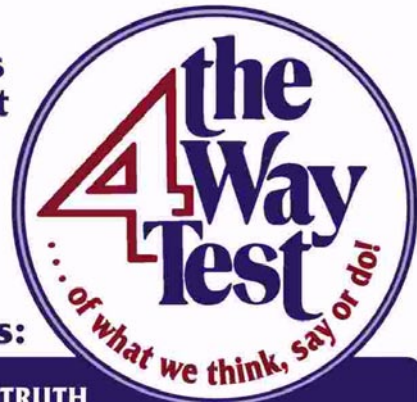


### Rotary’s 4-Way Test
