BECOME A "PALEY KIDS" AMBASSADOR

This is another local community service opportunity that we want to offer to our membership. As you know, President-Elect Robi Jurney is the Executive Director of Quantum House. Quantum House is located within the St. Mary's campus on 45th Street. Quantum House is a caring and supportive home that lessens the burden for families whose children are receiving treatment in Palm Beach County for a serious medical condition. Quantum House contains ten family suites, a large kitchen and dining room, indoor and outdoor play areas, and is the only facility of its kind between Ft. Lauderdale and Orlando. Our club volunteers quarterly in their Chef for a Day service program.

Caroline Eaton, another member of our Club, is employed at the Paley Advanced Limb Lengthening Institute, also located on St. Mary's campus. Dr. Dror Paley is a pioneer in the area of limb lengthening and limb deformity correction. 70% of his patients are less than 18 years old and the average age is 6 years old. These patients and a family member(s) travel from all over the world to be seen and treated by Dr. Paley. Many of the occupants at Quantum House are Paley patients and live in, what is for them a foreign environment, for 3-6 months at a time.

You can become a "Goodwill Ambassador" simply by committing to make a weekly phone call to your assigned patient and family. Just see how they are doing; answer any questions they may have; lend moral support; let them vent their frustrations and anxieties; refer them to local resources (restaurants, museums, shopping, schools); etc. If you want to take a more active role, you can assist with special events like Family Fun Days, or Babysitting Nights. You will be matched with your "family" based upon any similar interests or bonds, such as having children of like ages, nationality, fluency of foreign languages, etc.
