Rotary's NEWEST Service ABOVE Self Project

It isn't easy being a parent. We all make mistakes along the bumpy road of child-rearing. Some people have a more difficult time than others. Often, this is because they had poor role-models for their own parents. Fairfax County and NVFS (Northern Virginia Family Service) work together to change lives and provide Parenting Classes throughout the county.

We have been asked to help provide meals to the class participants once a week over a four week period on Monday evenings in September at the Fairfax Church of Christ (3901 Rugby Rd.). Club members are needed to step up and help provide a meal for 45 people. Approximately \$70 is required to provide the meal each week (Example of a meal: several frozen Stouffers lasagnas with bread and salad). The process is simple: Several club members need to come together and chip in the funds for the meal. One member needs to serve as the "Team Leader" for that week's meal. The Team Leader will make sure the food is purchased and delivered to the class location (either by doing it him/herself or delegating to a member of that week's team). Members can also help with serving the meal if desired. This is not required. **The Sign-Up Genius has been set-up.
