**Our Keynote Speaker:** Dr. David I. Steinberg has been a keynote speaker and workshop leader at many conferences and has consulted with public school systems, private schools, colleges and universities. He is Associate Professor of Organizational Leadership at Hood College. David has won awards for teaching, school leadership, and building parent, business, and community partnerships including the Washington Post Distinguished Educational Leadership Award.

**Attracting New Members:** Panel Discussion. Hear from fellow Rotarians tried and effective methods for attracting new members. All clubs need to grow. This session is for Membership chairs and all club leadership.

**Be A Vibrant Club.** Take your club from good to great. Learn ways to revitalize your club and better engage new and established members. This session is for presidents, presidents-elects, and club service chairs and all club leadership. *(offered twice)*

**DACdb (District And Club database) Training.** Learn the features and advantages of using DACdb to manage your club and member information. This session is for secretaries, presidents, presidents-elects and committee chairs.

**Grant Management 101- Applying for a District and Global Grant.** This session is for the club grant coordinator to gain familiarity with both the District and Global Grant process. An in depth look at applying for and qualifying for Foundation money.

**Public Image and Public Relations.** By increasing the public's understanding of Rotary, we're strengthening our ability to make an impact in communities around the world. This session is for PIPR chairs and all club leadership. *(offered twice)*

**Rotaract Panel.** Hear Rotaractors and past Rotaractors (now Rotarians) on the importance of membership for them, why they choose to be part of Rotary, and how to influence their peers. Hear ways to improve the exchange between a Rotaract Club and its sponsoring Rotary Club. This session is for Rotarians and Rotaractors.

**Rotaract 101.** What makes a successful Rotaract Club? Learn ways to organize your club, identify service projects, promote club successes, and attract potential members. This session is for Rotaract leadership.

**Rotary Foundation 101.** The basics of Rotary International's 4-Star foundation. The session is for all club leadership.

**Your Club's Liability.** What do you know about club insurance? What does the RI insurance policy cover and what's not covered? Learn about the steps to ensure that your club's liability is at a minimum. The session is for all club leadership.
