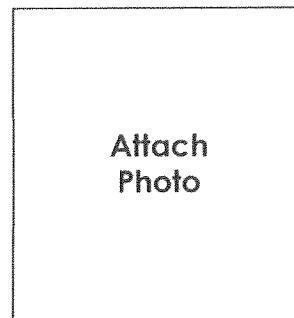

The Buzz Tennent Scholarship was established by The Rotary Club of Asheville to help scholars and encourage scholarship among high school seniors at Asheville High School. Buzz Tennent was a Past President of The Rotary Club of Asheville in 1939-1940. District Governor in 1943-1944, and President of Rotary International in 1957-1958.

It is essential that applicants supplement the information given on the front of this page. Following are some requirements and suggestions.

REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES:

1. Available to Asheville High School seniors between ages of 16 and 19 years.
2. Applicants preferred to have a 3.0 un-weighted grade point average.
3. Applicants preferred in the top 20 percent of their graduating class grade point average.
4. Present three letters of reference from teachers.
5. Present three letters of reference from out-of-school sources.
6. Provide Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) eligibility status information.
7. Provide a transcript of your high school record.
8. Submit a one or two page typed statement of your major aims in life and how you feel that this scholarship would help you reach those objectives.
9. Provide an estimation of total expenses for the first year of study.
10. Provide information on other scholarship awards.
11. Application must be postmarked no later than March 31.
12. Following interviews, selection of award winners will be made prior to June 1.
13. Notification of winners will be made within a week of selection.

Leadership, maturity, responsibility, personal outlook and ability to learn, as well as grades and test scores are among the factors that will have a bearing on the committee's selection and it will welcome the opportunity to review any information along these lines that will enable it to make the best choices.

These applicants selected as finalists will be expected to appear before the committee for an interview at a convenient time and place, anticipated to be during April.
