



District Simplified Grant (DSG) Application

August 26, 2011 is the deadline for Clubs to apply for a portion of DSG to support a Community Service Project that (1) Rotarians are actively involved in and (2) respects the wishes of the community. The District Foundation Committee will assess applications and award DSG grants to club projects. Grants cannot be used to buy land, buildings, for construction of buildings or for salaries, administrative expenses and travel. Please see "Terms and Conditions of District Simplified Grants" for further information and restrictions. The grant amount may vary by Project. To be eligible for a DSG, **the club must have averaged a minimum of \$40 per capita for the past two years. A Final report must be made as soon as the project is completed, and no later than May 15, 2012**, unless given written permission for other arrangements. Funding from RI is pending completion of reporting for past grants awarded. A club representative must be present at the District foundation Seminar, October 5, 2011, to receive their awarded funds.
