



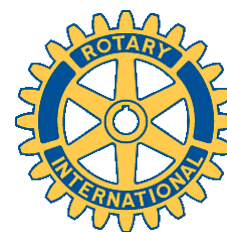
# Training Matters

## Self Study Assignment #4

**Required Items:**

1. Read Section 5, **Service Projects**, Pgs 71- 82, of the CLUB PRESIDENT'S MANUAL
2. Read Section 6 **The Rotary Foundation**, Pgs 83 - 96 of the CLUB PRESIDENT'S MANUAL
3. Find your club's historical TRF giving records for the past 5 years. If your Club President or Club Foundation Chair does not have this information, you should be able to get it from your District Rotary Foundation Chairman.
4. Find your own record of giving to The Rotary Foundation. This can be found in the Member Access section on the Rotary International website.
5. Bring a copy of your Club's current CRS (Club Recognition Summary) with you to PETS. If your Club President or Club Foundation Chair does not have this information you should be able to get it from your District Rotary Foundation chairman.
6. Research some statistics for your Club's annual giving. What percentage of your club's membership are Paul Harris Fellows? Multiple PHFs? Major Donors? Benefactors? Sustaining Members? EREY qualified?
7. What Rotary Foundation Programs has your Club participated in over the last 5 years?
8. What were your club's annual giving goals to TRF LAST year, and how close are you to achieving those goals?
9. What will be your goals for the coming year with respect to contributions to TRF and participation in its programs?

**Please bring this checklist with you to PETS, along with the materials you gathered as a part of this assignment.**
