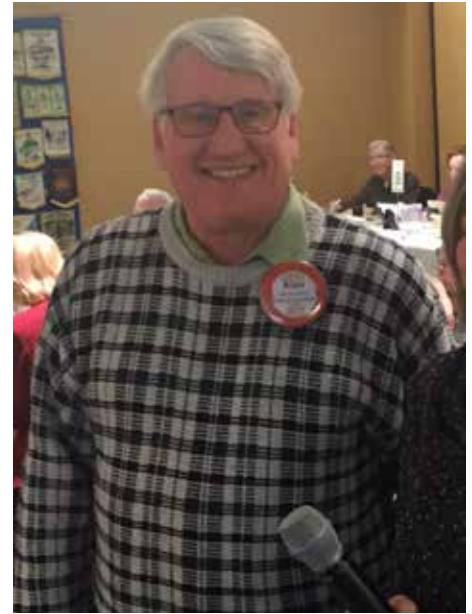

A friend and years-long investor for Marty defrauded him of a million dollars, the friend now being a poor brain and body crippled man near the end of his sad life. In attempts to recover what he could, Marty learned (and greatly improved) the laws governing restitution, coauthoring two California laws with Senator Quentin Kopp.

Assembly Woman Katherine Baker lauded Marty in her speech before us; and the Governor of California plaqued him.

Marty found most Judges to be mis-assigned or administratively and legally lazy, but in some cases actually seeking just results, if intelligently and patiently prodded by a knowledgeable and determined lege-ition.

Marty assisted the FBI and local and state Districts Attorney.

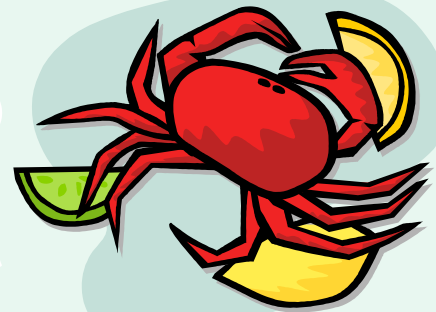
